Marla C. Dubinsky, MD

Director, Pediatric Inflammatory Bowel Disease Program Abe and Claire Levine Chair in Pediatric Inflammatory Bowel Disease

Professor of pediatrics at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center. She holds the Abe and Claire Levine Chair in Pediatric

inflammatory bowel disease (IBD). Her main objective is to study how genetics and immune responses impact on the variability in clinical presentations of early onset IBD. Additional interests include the study of pharmacogenetics to evaluate how heredity influences drug responses and optimizing and individualizing the management of IBD. Her

reviewed journals including Gastroenterology, The Journal of Pediatric Gastroenterology and Nutrition, Inflammatory Bowel Diseases, and the American Journal of Gastroenterology. In addition, she has authored book chapters for Trends in Inflammatory Bowel Disease Therapy and Inflammatory Bowel Disease: Diagnosis and Therapeutics. She is a member of several professional societies including the American Gastroenterology Association, the American

Alberta Children's Hospital in Calgary, Canada and her pediatric gastroenterology fellowship at Sainte-Justine Hospital at the University of Montreal in Quebec, Canada. She completed her research fellowship in pediatric gastroenterology
